WHAT IS THE WOODRIDGE ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB?

The Woodridge Athletic Booster Club is an independent nonprofit organization comprised of parents, coaches, faculty, alumni, and community members who are dedicated to providing additional resources to the athletic sports programs of the Woodridge School District.

The mission of the Booster Club is to raise and administer funds to supplement the high school and middle school athletic budgets with a primary objective of purchasing uniforms for our student athletes. Additionally, we work to increase attendance at athletic events, provide scholarships, and give recognition to student athletes across each sports season. Through these efforts, we aim to assist our coaches and staff in their mission to successfully develop excellent student athletes.

WHEN/WHERE DOES BOOSTER CLUB MEET?

The Booster Club meets at 7 p.m. on the second Wednesday of the month at The Workz on Front Street in August, September, October, November, February, March, April, and May.

HOW DO YOU BECOME A BOOSTER CLUB MEMBER?

Annual membership is open to anyone interested in supporting Woodridge athletes. To become an annual member, you can purchase one of the several available membership packages listed online at www.woodridgeboosterclub.com/store. There are a variety of levels (with swag) to meet any budget.

HOW DOES THE BOOSTER CLUB RAISE MONEY?

Primary sources of funding include our corporate sponsors, our annual memberships, and fundraising events held throughout the year, such as ads in this program, scoreboard ads, and the sale of Bulldog Cards. Our fundraising activities are vital to our athletic programs and are different than the fundraising that is done by individual teams. WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?

Our primary focus is ensuring each of our 34 teams across high school and middle school sports have proper, quality uniforms. The budget for our uniforms range from \$25,000 to \$30,000 annually. The Booster Club also provides ~\$7,000 in annual scholarships, senior banners for each sport, the Fall Sports Program, and Community Day t-shirts. We also support other campus-wide initiatives on an as-needed basis, such as the ticket booth and digital scoreboard.
